

## ICWIM8, Prague, May 19-23, 2019

## **Call for posters (without paper)**

This call for posters complements the call for abstracts and papers and encourages more participation at ICWIM8, e.g. industrials presenting innovative solutions, young researchers and PhD students presenting their works, other applied researchers presenting on-going research projects, and practitioners or end-users presenting case studies or experience with WIM. The objectives of these posters are to demonstrate the impact of research on industrial deployment and the implementation and use of WIM for various purposes. Industrial companies and practitioners are invited, beside the end-user forums/workshops, to actively contribute to the ICWIM8 by displaying achievements of industrial research. These posters will be displayed in an information arena and will be used for brainstorming and discussion between their authors and the delegates.

These posters should contain industrial innovations, case studies, or implementation of research work where preliminary results are available, including clear objectives and a detailed methodology. Original, recent and substantive achievements are expected. However, commercial advertising or presentation of market products are not accepted. These topics can be presented in company exhibition booths in the industrial exhibition.

The posters should address one or more of the ICWIM8 themes below. Accepted posters will be displayed on the conference site for at least one full day. Authors must bring their printed poster (A0 format, H=1.2 m, W=0.8 m) to ICWIM8 for posting on the designated location and day. Authors should remove their poster on the designated day. The conference organizers will provide mounting boards and materials for poster installation.

At least one author per poster must register to ICWIM8, before February 15, 2019, and attend the conference to present the poster. An author cannot be presenter of more than 2 posters.

By submitting a poster to ICWIM8, the authors automatically transfer their copyright to ISWIM for publication in the e-proceedings of the conference and on the ISWIM web site.

## Submission and Schedule:

Poster submissions deadline: December 15, 2018. A ready-for-presentation poster should be submitted on: <a href="https://www.is-wim.org/icwim8/">www.is-wim.org/icwim8/</a> in English only.

Poster notification (after a quick review): January 21, 2019.

Final version submission: February 28, 2019.
